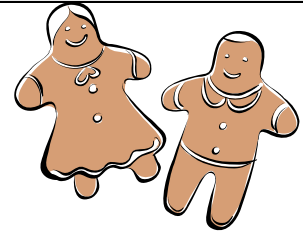


Trimark Properties has joined the Salvation Army in the effort to help needy children have a very merry Christmas!

- John's Tips -

Hi, it's time to talk again.

December is a month in which most of you will be leaving for at least a short period of time. Remember to lock all doors and windows, set the thermostat to 50 or 60 degrees on heat, check all water faucets and stove controls to be sure they are off and please do not shut off anything at the power panel. As cold weather comes upon us remember that GRU recommends setting your thermostat to 68 degrees and wearing enough clothes to keep yourself comfortable inside your apartment. If you choose to keep your apartment at a higher temperature, expect to pay more on your bill. Keep in mind that a month with 20 days of really cold weather is going to cost you more than a month with only 10 days. There are little things that you can do to help keep your apartment warm. Keep the windows closed and don't leave the front door open for extended amounts of time. If there are problems with cold air entering your apartment or you think the heater isn't working properly, please put a work order in right away so that maintenance can check it out as soon as possible. The only way maintenance can help you is if we know there is a problem. Please do not hesitate to ask for help. Have a great holiday and we will see you next year.
